



# SENATE BILL No. 768

July 21, 1993, Introduced by Senator FAXON, POLLACK,  
SCHWARZ and MC MANUS and referred to the Committee  
on Commerce.

A bill to amend Act No. 350 of the Public Acts of 1980,  
entitled as amended

"The nonprofit health care corporation reform act,"

as amended, being sections 500.1101 to 500.1704 of the Michigan  
Compiled Laws, by adding section 418.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 350 of the Public Acts of 1980, as  
2 amended, being sections 500.1101 to 500.1704 of the Michigan  
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 418 to read as  
4 follows:

5 SEC. 418. (1) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "CHILD HEALTH SUPER-  
6 VISION SERVICES" MEANS THE PERIODIC REVIEW OF A CHILD'S PHYSICAL  
7 AND EMOTIONAL STATUS BY A PHYSICIAN OR PURSUANT TO A PHYSICIAN'S  
8 SUPERVISION. A REVIEW SHALL INCLUDE A HISTORY, COMPLETE PHYSICAL  
9 EXAMINATION, DEVELOPMENTAL ASSESSMENT, ANTICIPATORY GUIDANCE,

1 APPROPRIATE IMMUNIZATIONS, AND LABORATORY TESTS IN KEEPING WITH  
2 PREVAILING MEDICAL STANDARDS.

3       (2) EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1995, A HEALTH CARE CORPORATION  
4 GROUP OR NONGROUP CERTIFICATE THAT OFFERS DEPENDENT BENEFITS  
5 SHALL PROVIDE THAT THE DEPENDENT BENEFITS APPLICABLE TO CHILDREN  
6 INCLUDE BENEFITS FOR CHILD HEALTH SUPERVISION SERVICES FROM THE  
7 MOMENT OF BIRTH THROUGH THE AGE OF 21. EACH SUCH CERTIFICATE  
8 SHALL PROVIDE BENEFITS, AT A MINIMUM, FOR CHILD HEALTH SUPERVI-  
9 SION SERVICES AT APPROXIMATELY THE FOLLOWING AGE INTERVALS:  
10 BIRTH, 2 MONTHS, 4 MONTHS, 6 MONTHS, 9 MONTHS, 12 MONTHS,  
11 15 MONTHS, 18 MONTHS, 2 YEARS, 3 YEARS, 4 YEARS, 5 YEARS,  
12 6 YEARS, 8 YEARS, 10 YEARS, 12 YEARS, 14 YEARS, 16 YEARS,  
13 18 YEARS, AND 20 YEARS. A CERTIFICATE MAY PROVIDE THAT CHILD  
14 HEALTH SUPERVISION SERVICES THAT ARE RENDERED DURING A PERIODIC  
15 REVIEW SHALL ONLY BE COVERED TO THE EXTENT THAT THOSE SERVICES  
16 ARE PROVIDED BY OR UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A SINGLE PHYSICIAN  
17 DURING THE COURSE OF 1 VISIT.

18       (3) BENEFITS FOR CHILD HEALTH SUPERVISION SERVICES SHALL BE  
19 EXEMPT FROM ANY COPAYMENT, COINSURANCE, DEDUCTIBLE, OR DOLLAR  
20 LIMIT PROVISIONS IN THE CERTIFICATE, AND SUCH EXEMPTION SHALL BE  
21 EXPLICITLY PROVIDED FOR IN THE CERTIFICATE.
