



SENATE BILL No. 773

July 21, 1993, Introduced by Senators KELLY, MILLER, KOIVISTO, HART, FAUST, BOUCHARD and GEAKE and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, entitled as amended

"The Michigan penal code,"

as amended, being sections 750.1 to 750.568 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 529a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, as
2 amended, being sections 750.1 to 750.568 of the Michigan Compiled
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 529a to read as follows:

4 SEC. 529A. A PERSON WHO ROBS, STEALS, OR TAKES A MOTOR
5 VEHICLE AS DEFINED IN SECTION 412 FROM ANOTHER PERSON BY FORCE OR
6 VIOLENCE, BY THREAT OF FORCE OR VIOLENCE, OR BY PUTTING IN FEAR
7 AND IN THE OTHER PERSON'S PRESENCE OR THE PRESENCE OF A PASSENGER
8 OR ANY OTHER PERSON IN LAWFUL POSSESSION OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE IS

1 GUILTY OF AUTO PIRACY, WHICH IS A FELONY, AND SHALL BE PUNISHED
2 BY IMPRISONMENT FOR LIFE OR FOR ANY TERM OF YEARS BUT NOT LESS
3 THAN 10 YEARS.
