

## **SENATE BILL No. 779**

July 21, 1993, Introduced by Senators KELLY, MILLER, KOIVISTO, HART, FAUST, BOUCHARD and GEAKE and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend section 2 of Act No. 13 of the Public Acts of 1988, entitled

"Juvenile diversion act,"

being section 722.822 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 2 of Act No. 13 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1988, being section 722.822 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 5 (a) "Assaultive crime" means an offense —which— THAT, if
- 6 committed by an adult, would constitute an offense against a
- 7 person described in any of the following sections: SECTION 82
- 8 -to 83, 84, 86, 87, 88, 89, 316, 317, 321, 349, -to-349A, 350,
- 9 397, -520a to 520B, 520C, 520D, 520E, 520g, 529, -and 529A, OR

- 1 530 of the Michigan penal code, Act No. 328 of the Public Acts
- 2 of 1931, being sections 750.82, -to- 750.83, 750.84, 750.86,
- 3 750.87, 750.88, 750.89, 750.316, 750.317, 750.321, 750.349, <del>to</del>
- 4 750.349A, 750.350, 750.397, <del>750.520a to </del>750.520B, 750.520C,
- 5 750.520D, 750.520E, 750.520g, 750.529, 750.529A, and 750.530 of
- 6 the Michigan Compiled Laws.
- 7 (b) "Court" means the juvenile division of the probate 8 court.
- 9 (c) "Divert" or "diversion" means the placement that occurs
- 10 when a formally recorded apprehension is made by a law enforce-
- 11 ment agency for an act by a minor that if a petition were filed
- 12 with the court would bring that minor within section 2(a) of
- 13 chapter XIIA of Act No. 288 of the Public Acts of 1939, being
- 14 section 712A.2 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, and instead of
- 15 petitioning the court or authorizing a petition, either of the
- 16 following occurs:
- 17 (i) The minor is released into the custody of his or her
- 18 parent, guardian, or custodian and the investigation is
- 19 discontinued.
- 20 (ii) The minor and the minor's parent, guardian, or custo-
- 21 dian agree to work with a person or public or private organi-
- 22 zation or agency that will assist the minor and the minor's
- 23 family in resolving the problem that initiated the
- 24 investigation.
- 25 (d) "Law enforcement agency" means a police department of a
- 26 city, village, or township, --- a sheriff's department, --- the

- 1 department of state police, -- or any other governmental law
- 2 enforcement agency in this state.
- 3 (e) "Minor" means -a person AN INDIVIDUAL less than 17
- 4 years of age.
- 5 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
- 6 Senate Bill No. 773
- of the 87th Legislature is enacted into law.
