

SENATE BILL No. 789

August 3, 1993, Introduced by Senators HOFFMAN, DINGELL, DUNASKISS and EHLERS and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs.

A bill to amend Act No. 269 of the Public Acts of 1989, entitled

"An act to provide civil immunity to persons who operate or use certain sport shooting ranges; and to regulate the application of state and local laws, rules, regulations, and ordinances regarding sport shooting ranges,"

being sections 691.1541 to 691.1543 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 4.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Act No. 269 of the Public Acts of 1989, being
- 2 sections 691.1541 to 691.1543 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended by adding section 4 to read as follows:
- 4 SEC. 4. A PERSON WHO OWNS OR OPERATES A SPORT SHOOTING
- 5 RANGE IS IMMUNE FROM CIVIL LIABILITY WHICH MIGHT OTHERWISE BE
- 6 INCURRED IN AN ACTION FILED BY A PERSON WHO PARTICIPATES IN SPORT
- 7 SHOOTING FROM DANGERS AND RISKS THAT ARE OBVIOUS AND INHERENT IN

- 1 THE PARTICIPATION IN SPORT SHOOTING. SUCH OBVIOUS AND NECESSARY
- 2 DANGERS INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO INJURIES THAT CAN RESULT
- 3 FROM NOISE, DISCHARGE OF A PROJECTILE OR SHOT, MALFUNCTION OF
- 4 EQUIPMENT, FACILITY DESIGN, AND VARIATIONS IN TERRAIN.
- 5 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless

- of the 87th Legislature is enacted into law.
