



SENATE BILL No. 835

September 21, 1993, Introduced by Senators BERRYMAN, KOIVISTO, FAUST, KELLY, O'BRIEN, CHERRY, DINGELL, MILLER and WELBORN and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend Act No. 17 of the Public Acts of 1921, entitled as amended

"An act to provide for the protection and conservation of the natural resources of the state; to provide and develop facilities for outdoor recreation; to create a conservation department; to define the powers and duties thereof; to provide rules and regulations concerning the use and occupancy of lands and property under its control and penalties for the violation thereof; to provide for the transfer to said department of the powers and duties now vested by law in certain boards, commissions and officers of the state; and for the abolishing of the boards, commissions and offices the powers and duties of which are hereby transferred,"

as amended, being sections 299.1 to 299.10 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 4a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 17 of the Public Acts of 1921, as
2 amended, being sections 299.1 to 299.10 of the Michigan Compiled
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 4a to read as follows:

1 SEC. 4A. (1) AS USED IN THIS SECTION "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE
2 DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES.

3 (2) BEGINNING ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION, FOR AT
4 LEAST 3 YEARS AFTER TERMINATING HIS OR HER EMPLOYMENT WITH THE
5 DEPARTMENT, A PERSON SHALL NOT ACCEPT EMPLOYMENT WITH OR ENTER
6 INTO A CONTRACTUAL RELATIONSHIP WITH A PERSON OR OTHER ENTITY
7 THAT HAS OR HAD OBTAINED A PERMIT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OR IS OR
8 HAS BEEN SUBJECT TO A DEPARTMENT ENFORCEMENT OR COMPLIANCE
9 ACTION.
