

SENATE BILL No. 865

October 5, 1993, Introduced by Senators WELBORN, WARTNER and HONIGMAN and referred to the Committee on Local Government and Urban Development.

A bill to amend section 3a of Act No. 156 of the Public Acts of 1851, entitled as amended

"An act to define the powers and duties of the county boards of commissioners of the several counties, and to confer upon them certain local, administrative and legislative powers; and to prescribe penalties for the violation of the provisions of this act,"

being section 46.3a of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 3a of Act No. 156 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1851, being section 46.3a of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 3a. The names and votes of members shall be recorded
- 5 on an action -which is taken by the board of county commission-
- 6 ers or by a committee of the board of county commissioners if the
- 7 action is on an ordinance, resolution, or appointment or election
- 8 of an officer. -, except the vote for chairman may be by secret

- 2 questions or motions shall be recorded at the request of -- 1/5
- 3 of the members present if the question or motion is before the
- 4 board, or 1/3 of the members present if the question or motion is
- 5 before a committee of the board. A record -which is made pursu-
- 6 ant to this section shall be available for public inspection.
