A bill to amend Act No 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, entitled as amended
"Public health code,"
as amended, being sections 333 1101 to 333 25211 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding sections 17018, 17061, 17218, 17518, 17723, 17831, and 18225

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

1 Section 1 Act No 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, as
