



# SENATE BILL No. 1003

February 2, 1994, Introduced by Senator VAN REGENMORTER  
and referred to the Committee on Judiciary

A bill to amend section 3 of Act No 250 of the Public Acts  
of 1990 entitled  
"DNA identification profiling system act,"  
being section 28 173 of the Michigan Compiled Laws and to repeal  
certain parts of the act

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

1 Section 1 Section 3 of Act No 250 of the Public Acts of  
2 1990, being section 28 173 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is  
3 amended to read as follows

4 Sec 3 Not later than ~~January 1, 1993~~ OCTOBER 1, 1994,  
5 the department of state police shall promulgate rules pursuant to  
6 the administrative procedures act of 1969, Act No 306 of the  
7 Public Acts of 1969, being sections 24 201 to 24 328 of the

1 Michigan Compiled Laws, to implement this act, including, but not  
2 limited to, rules governing all of the following

3       (a) The method of collection of blood and saliva samples,  
4 and the types and number of samples to be collected, by the  
5 department of corrections from certain prisoners pursuant to sec-  
6 tion 33d of Act No 232 of the Public Acts of 1953, being section  
7 791 233d of the Michigan Compiled Laws, and by law enforcement  
8 agencies from certain convicted offenders pursuant to  
9 section 520m of the Michigan penal code, Act No 328 of the  
10 Public Acts of 1931, being section 750 520m of the Michigan  
11 Compiled Laws   The rules shall provide for the taking of blood  
12 and saliva samples in a medically approved manner by qualified  
13 persons

14       (b) The distribution of blood specimen vials, mailing tubes,  
15 and labels and of instructions for the collection of blood and  
16 saliva samples

17       (c) The storage and transmission to the department of state  
18 police of the blood and saliva samples described in subdivision  
19 (a)

20       (d) The DNA identification or genetic marker profiling of  
21 the blood and saliva samples described in subdivision (a) and of  
22 other blood, saliva, or tissue samples submitted to the depart-  
23 ment of state police

24       (e) The development, in cooperation with the federal bureau  
25 of investigation and other appropriate persons of a system of  
26 filing, cataloging, retrieval, and comparison of DNA  
27 identification profiles, and the computerization of this system

1 (f) The protection of the privacy interests of individuals  
2 whose blood, saliva, or tissue samples are analyzed pursuant to  
3 this act

4 Section 2 Sections 7 and 8 of Act No 250 of the Public  
5 Acts of 1990, being sections 28 177 and 28 178 of the Michigan  
6 Compiled Laws, are repealed

7 Section 3 Act No 250 of the Public Acts of 1990, as  
8 amended by this amendatory act, shall take effect April 1, 1994
