THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

1 Section 1 Act No 8 of the Public Acts of the Extra
2 Session of 1933, as amended, being sections 436 1 to 436 58 of
3 the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 24b to
4 read as follows
5 SEC 24B (1) AN OFF-PREMISES OR ON-PREMISES RETAIL LICENSE
6 USING SIGNAGE INSIDE THE LICENSED PREMISES FOR THE ADVERTISING OF
7 ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR IS REQUIRED TO INCLUDE A WARNING AS TO THE
8 DANGERS ASSOCIATED WITH THE USE OF ALCOHOL DURING PREGNANCY THE
9 WARNING REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION SHALL APPEAR WITHIN THE TEXT OF

1 THE ADVERTISING, IF ANY, OR WHERE THE BRAND NAME PROMINENTLY
2 APPEARS

3 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "SIGNAGE" MEANS ALL OF THE
4 FOLLOWING

5 (A) A SIGN ADVERTISING ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR

6 (B) A NECESSARY PART OF A SIGN ADVERTISING ALCOHOLIC
7 LIQUOR

8 (C) ANY SIGN ATTACHED TO A SIGN ADVERTISING ALCOHOLIC
9 LIQUOR
