- (c) "Legal guardian" means a person appointed by a court of
- 23 competent jurisdiction to exercise powers over a family member
- (d) "Parent" means a biological or adoptive parent

- 26 rized under title XVI of the social security act, CHAPTER 531, 49
- 27 STAT 620, 42 U S C 1381 to -1383c- 13827 AND 1383 TO 1383d
