

## SENATE BILL No. 1084

April 12 1994 Introduced by Senator DILLINGHAM and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Tourism

A bill to amend sections 5 7 10 and 10a of Act No 187 of the Public Acts of 1990 entitled
"The pupil transportation act,"
section 7 as amended by Act No 227 of the Public Acts of 1992 and section 10a as added by Act No 322 of the Public Acts of 1990, being sections 257 1805, 257 1807 257 1810, and 257 1810a of the Michigan Compiled Laws and to add section 20

- 2 CONTINUOUS HIGH SPEED TRAVEL THAT IS DESIGNED FOR MAXIMUM

- 2 (b) New tires on the front axle
- 3 (c) New recap tires on the rear axle
- 4 (d) New brake linings and drums
- 5 (e) New hydraulic brake lines
- 6 (f) New front and rear springs

- 8 (h) New exhaust system
- 9 (10) -(6)- "Rule" means a rule promulgated pursuant to the
- 10 administrative procedures act of 1969, Act No 306 of the Public
- 11 Acts of 1969, being sections 24 201 to 24 328 of the Michigan
- 12 Compiled Laws
- 13 (11) -(7) "School" means either a public school or a non-
- 14 public school, -or both AN EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION PROGRAM
- 15 APPROVED BY THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION, OR A HEAD START PROGRAM
- 16 APPROVED BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT SCHOOL DOES NOT INCLUDE A
- 17 PUBLIC OR PRIVATE COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY
- 18 Sec 7 (1) "School bus" means a motor vehicle other than

- 14 TRANSPORTATION OF PUPILS TO OR FROM SCHOOL OR SCHOOL-RELATED
- 15 EVENTS SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION VEHICLE DOES NOT INCLUDE A VEHICLE
- 16 USED BY A PARENT OR PARENT'S DESIGNEE TO TRANSPORT CHILDREN TO OR

- 23 with a passenger capacity of over 66 pupils and any other school

- 3 Sec 10 (1) Each motor vehicle owned OR OPERATED by a
- 4 public -- OR private -- or governmental agency and operated-

- 6 portation of -passengers- PUPILS to or from school -and- OR
- 7 school-related events shall meet or exceed the passenger protec-

- 26 AUTHORIZATION SHALL BE IN WRITING AND CONTAIN SUCH CONDITIONS OR

- 1 RESTRICTIONS AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO SAFEGUARD THE WELFARE OF THE
- 2 PUPILS
- 3 SEC 20 (1) A SCHOOL BUS MANUFACTURED ON OR AFTER
- 4 SEPTEMBER 1 1992 SHALL NOT BE PURCHASED UNLESS IT IS EQUIPPED
- 5 WITH A STOP SIGNAL ARM HAVING 2 RED FLASHING LAMPS
- 6 (2) A SCHOOL BUS PURCHASED OR RETROFITTED WITH A STOP SIGNAL

- 14 (4) A SCHOOL BUS SHALL NOT BE EQUIPPED WITH A STOP SIGNAL
- 15 ARM UNLESS EQUIPPED WITH THE LAMPS REQUIRED IN SECTION 19(2)
