

## SENATE BILL No. 1087

April 12, 1994, Introduced by Senator ARTHURHULTZ and referred to the Committee on Government Operations

A bill to amend section 26 of Act No 388 of the Public Acts of 1976 entitled

"Michigan campaign finance act,"

as amended by Act No 95 of the Public Acts of 1989 being section 169 226 of the Michigan Compiled Laws and to add section 21a

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

- 1 Section 1 Section 26 of Act No 388 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1976, as amended by Act No 95 of the Public Acts of 1989, being
- 3 section 169 226 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended and
- 4 section 21a is added to read as follows
- SEC 21A SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION, A CANDIDATE COMMITTEE
- 6 FOR A CANDIDATE FOR THE OFFICE OF STATE REPRESENTATIVE OR STATE
- 7 SENATOR MAY ACCEPT CONTRIBUTIONS THE CANDIDATE COMMITTEE FOR A
- 8 CANDIDATE FOR THE OFFICE OF STATE REPRESENTATIVE OR STATE SENATOR

- 1 SHALL ONLY ACCEPT CONTRIBUTIONS DURING EACH ELECTION CYCLE SO
- 2 THAT THE CUMULATIVE TOTAL OF CONTRIBUTIONS FROM INDEPENDENT COM-
- 3 MITTEES AND POLITICAL COMMITTEES DOES NOT EXCEED THE CUMULATIVE
- 4 TOTAL OF CONTRIBUTIONS FROM INDIVIDUALS RESIDING IN THE DISTRICT
- 5 OF THE OFFICE BEING SOUGHT BY THE CANDIDATE A PERSON WHO VIO-
- 6 LATES THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO A CIVIL FINE OF NOT MORE THAN
- 7 \$10,000 00 FOR EACH VIOLATION
- 8 Sec 26 (1) A campaign statement of a committee other
- 9 than a political party committee, required by this act shall con-
- 10 tain all of the following information
- 11 (a) The filing committee's name, address, and telephone
- 12 number, and the full name, residential and business addresses
- 13 and telephone numbers of -its- THE committee treasurer
- 14 (b) Under the heading "receipts" the total amount of con-
- 15 tributions received during the period covered by the campaign
- 16 statement under the heading "expenditures" the total amount of
- 17 expenditures made during the period covered by the campaign
- 18 statement and the cumulative amount of those totals
- 19 Forgiveness of a loan shall not be included in the totals
- 20 Payment of a loan by a third party shall be recorded and reported
- 21 as an in-kind contribution by the third party In-kind contribu-
- 22 tions or expenditures shall be listed at fair market value and
- 23 shall be reported as both contributions and expenditures A con-
- 24 tribution or expenditure -which THAT is by other than completed
- 25 and accepted payment, gift, or other transfer, -which is clearly
- 26 not legally enforceable, and -which is expressly withdrawn or
- 27 rejected and returned before a campaign statement closing date

- 1 need not be included in the campaign statement and if included
- 2 may, in a later or amended statement be shown as a deduction,
- 3 but adequate records of each instance shall be kept
- 4 (c) The balance of cash on hand at the beginning and the end
- 5 of the period covered by the campaign statement
- 6 (d) The total amount of contributions received during the
- 7 period covered by the campaign statement from persons who con-
- 8 tributed \$20 01 or more
- 9 (e) The total amount of contributions received during the
- 10 period covered by the campaign statement from persons who con-
- 11 tributed \$20 00 or less
- 12 (f) The total amount of contributions of \$20 00 or less
- 13 received during the period covered by the campaign statement and
- 14 the cumulative amount of the contributions received by the filer
- 15 pursuant to section 41(3)
- 16 (g) The following information regarding each fund-raising
- 17 event shall be included in the report
- 18 (1) The type of event, date held, address and name, if any,
- 19 of the place where the activity was held, and approximate number
- 20 of individuals participating or in attendance
- 21 (11) The total amount of all contributions of \$20 01 or
- 22 more
- 23 (111) The total amount of all contributions of \$20 00 or
- 24 less
- 25 (1V) The gross receipts of the fund-raising event
- 26 (v) The expenditures incident to the event

- 1 (h) The full name of each individual from whom contributions
- 2 totaling \$20 01 or more are received during the period covered by
- 3 the campaign statement, together with the individual's street
- 4 address, the amount contributed the date on which each contribu-
- 5 tion was received, and the cumulative amount contributed by that
- 6 individual The occupation, employer, and principal place of
- 7 business shall be stated if the individual's cumulative contribu-
- 8 tions are \$200 01 or more
- 9 (1) The cumulative amount contributed and the name and
- 10 address of each individual, except those individuals reported
- 11 under subdivision (h) who contributed a total of \$20 01 or
- 12 more The occupation employer, and principal place of business,
- 13 shall be stated for each individual who contributed \$200 01 or
- 14 more
- 15 (7) The name and street address of each person, other than
- 16 an individual, from whom contributions are received during the
- 17 period covered by the campaign statement, together with an item-
- 18 ization of the amounts contributed the date on which each con-
- 19 tribution was received and the cumulative amount contributed by
- 20 that person
- 21 (k) The name address and amount given by an individual who
- 22 contributed \$20 01 or more of the total amount contributed by a
- 23 person who is other than a committee or an individual The occu-
- 24 pation employer and principal place of business shall be stated
- 25 if the individual contributed \$200 01 or more of the total amount
- 26 contributed by a person who is other than a committee or an
- 27 individual

- 1 (1) The cumulative total of expenditures of \$50 00 or less
- 2 made during the period covered by the campaign statement except
- 3 for expenditures made to or on behalf of another committee, can-
- 4 didate, or ballot question
- 5 (m) The full name and street address of each person to whom
- 6 expenditures totaling \$50 01 or more were made together with the
- 7 amount of each separate expenditure to each such person during
- 8 the period covered by the campaign statement the purpose of the
- 9 expenditure the full name and street address of the person pro-
- 10 viding the consideration for which any expenditure was made if
- 11 different from the payee the itemization regardless of amount of
- 12 each expenditure made to or on behalf of another committee can-
- 13 didate, or ballot question and the cumulative amount of expendi-
- 14 tures for or against that candidate or ballot question for an
- 15 election cycle An expenditure made in support of more than 1
- 16 candidate or ballot question or both, shall be apportioned rea-
- 17 sonably among the candidates or ballot questions, or both
- 18 (N) FOR A CANDIDATE COMMITTEE FOR A CANDIDATE FOR STATE REP-
- 19 RESENTATIVE OR STATE SENATOR, THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF CONTRIBUTIONS
- 20 RECEIVED DURING THE PERIOD COVERED BY THE CAMPAIGN STATEMENT FROM
- 21 INDEPENDENT COMMITTEES AND POLITICAL COMMITTEES AND FROM INDIVID-
- 22 UALS RESIDING IN THE DISTRICT OF THE OFFICE BEING SOUGHT BY THE
- 23 CANDIDATE
- (2) A candidate committee or ballot question committee shall
- 25 report all cumulative amounts required by this section on a per
- 26 election cycle basis Except for -subdivision (m)-
- 27 SUBSECTION (1)(M), an independent committee or political

- 1 committee shall report all cumulative amounts required by this
- 2 section on a calendar year basis
