

## SENATE BILL No. 1089

April 12 1994, Introduced by Senator ARTHURHULTZ and referred to the Committee on Government Operations

A bill to amend the title and sections 22, 26, 28, 29, 41, and 42 of Act No 388 of the Public Acts of 1976 entitled "Michigan campaign finance act" sections 22 26 28, 29, and 42 as amended by Act No 95 of the Public Acts of 1989, being sections 169 222, 169 226, 169 228, 169 229, 169 241, and 169 242 of the Michigan Compiled Laws and to add section 46a

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT
