

## **SENATE BILL No. 1170**

May 25, 1994, Introduced by Senators FAXON and SMITH and referred to the Committee on Judiciary

A bill to amend chapter IX of Act No 175 of the Public Acts of 1927, entitled as amended
"The code of criminal procedure,"

as amended, being sections 769 1 to 769 28 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 4b

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

- 1 Section 1 Chapter IX of Act No 175 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1927, as amended, being sections 769 1 to 769 28 of the Michigan
- 3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 4b to read as
- 4 follows
- 5 CHAPTER IX
- 6 SEC 4B WHEN AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS NOT PREVIOUSLY BEEN
- 7 CONVICTED OF VIOLATING SECTION 356C, 356D, OR 356E OF THE
- 8 MICHIGAN PENAL CODE, ACT NO 328 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1931,
- 9 BEING SECTIONS 750 356C, 750 356D AND 750 356E OF THE MICHIGAN

- 1 COMPILED LAWS, OR A LOCAL ORDINANCE SUBSTANTIALLY CORRESPONDING
- 2 TO SECTION 356D OR 356E OF ACT NO 328 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1931
- 3 PLEADS GUILTY TO OR IS FOUND GUILTY OF VIOLATING SECTION 356E OF
- 4 ACT NO 328 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1931, THE COURT, WITHOUT ENTER-
- 5 ING A JUDGMENT OF GUILT AND WITH THE CONSENT OF THE ACCUSED, MAY
- 6 DEFER FURTHER PROCEEDINGS AND PLACE THE INDIVIDUAL ON PROBATION
- 7 UPON TERMS AND CONDITIONS THAT SHALL INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED
- 8 TO, PAYMENT OF A PROBATION SUPERVISION FEE AS PRESCRIBED IN SEC-
- 9 TION 3C OF CHAPTER XI UPON VIOLATION OF A TERM OR CONDITION,
- 10 THE COURT MAY ENTER AN ADJUDICATION OF GUILT AND PROCEED AS OTH-
- 11 ERWISE PROVIDED UPON FULFILLMENT OF THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS,
- 12 THE COURT SHALL DISCHARGE THE INDIVIDUAL AND DISMISS THE
- 13 PROCEEDINGS DISCHARGE AND DISMISSAL UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE
- 14 WITHOUT ADJUDICATION OF GUILT AND IS NOT A CONVICTION FOR PUR-
- 15 POSES OF THIS SECTION OR FOR PURPOSES OF DISQUALIFICATIONS OR
- 16 DISABILITIES IMPOSED BY LAW UPON CONVICTION OF A CRIME THERE
- 17 MAY BE ONLY 1 DISCHARGE AND DISMISSAL UNDER THIS SECTION AS TO AN
- 18 INDIVIDUAL THE RECORDS AND IDENTIFICATIONS DIVISION OF THE
- 19 DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE SHALL RETAIN A NONPUBLIC RECORD OF AN
- 20 ARREST AND DISCHARGE OR DISMISSAL UNDER THIS SECTION THIS
- 21 RECORD SHALL BE FURNISHED TO A COURT OR POLICE AGENCY UPON
- 22 REQUEST FOR THE PURPOSE OF SHOWING THAT A DEFENDANT IN A CRIMINAL
- 23 ACTION UNDER SECTION 356E OF ACT NO 328 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF
- 24 1931 HAS ALREADY ONCE UTILIZED THIS SECTION FOR PURPOSES OF
- 25 THIS SECTION, A PERSON SUBJECTED TO A CIVIL FINE FOR A FIRST VIO-
- 26 LATION OF A LOCAL ORDINANCE SUBSTANTIALLY CORRESPONDING TO
- 27 SECTION 356E OF ACT NO 328 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1931 SHALL NOT

- 1 BE CONSIDERED TO HAVE PREVIOUSLY BEEN CONVICTED OF AN OFFENSE
- 2 UNDER THIS ARTICLE
- 3 Section 2 This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
- 4 all of the following bills of the 87th Legislature are enacted
- 5 into law
