A bill to amend section 3 of chapter V of Act No 215 of the Public Acts of 1895, entitled as amended

"The fourth class city act,"

being section 85 3 of the Michigan Compiled Laws

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

- 1 Section 1 Section 3 of chapter V of Act No 215 of the
- 2 Public Acts of 1895, being section 85 3 of the Michigan Compiled
- 3 Laws, is amended to read as follows
- 4 CHAPTER V
- 5 Sec 3 (1) A city attorney, city marshal, street commis-
- 6 sioner, city surveyor, -a- city assessor when provided for, and
- 7 -a- chief engineer of the fire department shall be appointed by
- 8 the mayor, -by and with the consent of the council The council
- 9 may also provide by ordinance for the appointment of, for the
- 10 term prescribed in the ordinance, other officers whose election

- 1 or appointment is not specially provided for in this act -, as
- 2 the council considers necessary for the execution of the powers
- 3 granted by this act These appointments shall be made by the
- 4 mayor, -by and with the consent of the council, and -their THE
- 5 powers and duties OF THE OFFICERS shall be prescribed by
- 6 ordinance The mayor shall not have a vote in the council
- 7 regarding mayoral appointments of those officers
- 8 (2) THE COUNCIL MAY APPOINT A CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER
- 9 FOR A TERM PRESCRIBED BY ORDINANCE UNDER SUBSECTION (1) OR TO
- 10 SERVE AT THE PLEASURE OF THE COUNCIL IF THE CHIEF ADMINISTRA-
- 11 TIVE OFFICER SERVES AT THE PLEASURE OF THE COUNCIL, THE COUNCIL
- 12 MAY ENTER INTO AN EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT WITH THE CHIEF ADMINISTRA-
- 13 TIVE OFFICER EXTENDING BEYOND THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS OF THE
- 14 COUNCIL AN EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT WITH THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE
- 15 OFFICER SHALL BE IN WRITING AND SHALL SPECIFY THE COMPENSATION TO
- 16 BE PAID TO THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER, ANY PROCEDURE FOR
- 17 CHANGING THE COMPENSATION, ANY FRINGE BENEFITS, AND ANY OTHER
- 18 CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT THE CONTRACT SHALL STATE THAT THE
- 19 CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER SERVES AT THE PLEASURE OF THE
- 20 COUNCIL THE CONTRACT MAY PROVIDE FOR SEVERANCE PAY OR OTHER
- 21 BENEFITS IN THE EVENT THE EMPLOYMENT OF THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE
- 22 OFFICER IS TERMINATED AT THE PLEASURE OF THE COUNCIL
- 23 (3) -(2) A writing prepared, owned, used, in the possession
- 24 of, or retained by a board, commission, or committee created
- 25 under this act in the performance of an official function shall
- 26 be made available to the public in compliance with THE FREEDOM OF
