A bill to amend Act No 218 of the Public Acts of 1956,
entitled as amended

"The insurance code of 1956 "

as amended, being sections 500 100 to 500 8302 of the Michigan
Compiled Laws, by adding section 3406f

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

1 Section 1 Act No 218 of the Public Acts of 1956, as
2 amended, being sections 500 100 to 500 8302 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws is amended by adding section 3406f to read as
4 follows

5 SEC 3406F (1) EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1995, AN INSURER THAT
6 DELIVERS, ISSUES FOR DELIVERY, OR RENEWS IN THIS STATE AN
7 EXPENSE-INCURRED HOSPITAL, SURGICAL, OR MEDICAL POLICY OR
8 CERTIFICATE THAT OFFERS DEPENDENT COVERAGE SHALL PROVIDE OR OFFER
9 TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPENDENT COVERAGE APPLICABLE TO CHILDREN

1 INCLUDE COVERAGE FOR VACCINES TO IMMUNIZE AGAINST THE DISEASES
2 AND INFECTIONS LISTED IN SECTION 9202 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE,
3 ACT NO 368 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1978, BEING SECTION 333 9202 OF
4 THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS, AND SHALL PROVIDE OR OFFER TO PROVIDE
5 FOR COVERAGE FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE VACCINES FROM THE
6 MOMENT OF BIRTH OR PLACEMENT FOR ADOPTION THROUGH THE AGE OF 18

7 (2) COVERAGE UNDER SUBSECTION (1) IS NOT SUBJECT TO ANY
8 COPAYMENTS, COINSURANCE PROVISIONS, DEDUCTIBLES, OR DOLLAR
9 LIMITS, AND THIS EXEMPTION SHALL BE EXPLICITLY PROVIDED FOR IN
10 THE POLICY OR CERTIFICATE

11 (3) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO LIMITED CLASSIFICATION
12 POLICIES

13 (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "LIMITED CLASSIFICATION
14 POLICIES" MEANS AN ACCIDENT ONLY POLICY OR CERTIFICATE, A LIMITED
15 ACCIDENT POLICY OR CERTIFICATE, OR A SPECIFIED DISEASE POLICY OR
16 CERTIFICATE
