

SENATE BILL No. 1228

September 14, 1994, Introduced by Senator HONIGMAN and referred to the Committee on Labor

A bill to amend the title and section 3 of Act No 133 of the Public Acts of 1955, entitled

"An act to provide for the granting of military leaves and providing re-employment protection for officers and enlisted men of the military or naval forces of the state or of the United States,"

being section 32 273 of the Michigan Compiled Laws

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

- Section 1 The title and section 3 of Act No 133 of the
- 2 Public Acts of 1955, being section 32 273 of the Michigan
- 3 Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows
- 4 TITLE
- 5 An act to provide for the granting of CERTAIN POLICE OFFICER
- 6 TRAINING AND military leaves, and providing TO PROVIDE FOR
- 7 re-employment protection for CERTAIN POLICE OFFICERS AND FOR

- 1 officers and enlisted men AND WOMEN of the military or naval
- 2 forces of the state or of the United States
- 3 Sec 3 (1) No AN employee who requests a leave from his
- 4 OR HER employment FOR THE FOLLOWING REASONS shall NOT be denied a
- 5 leave of absence by his OR HER employer for the purpose of
- 6 being inducted into, entering, determining his physical fitness
- 7 to enter, or performing training duty as an officer or enlisted
- 8 man of
- 9 (A) TO ENTER OR BE INDUCTED INTO the military or naval
- 10 forces of the state or -of- the United States -Upon his release
- 11 from such training duty or upon his rejection, such
- 12 (B) TO HAVE HIS OR HER PHYSICAL FITNESS FOR SERVICE IN THE
- 13 MILITARY OR NAVAL FORCES OF THE STATE OR THE UNITED STATES
- 14 DETERMINED
- 15 (C) TO PERFORM TRAINING DUTY AS AN OFFICER OR ENLISTED
- 16 PERSON OF THE MILITARY OR NAVAL FORCES OF THE STATE OR THE UNITED
- 17 STATES
- 18 (D) TO PERFORM TRAINING DUTY AS A POLICE OFFICER IF THAT
- 19 TRAINING DUTY OCCURS NOT MORE THAN 2 WEEKS PER CALENDAR YEAR AND
- 20 AN ADDITIONAL 2 WEEKENDS PER MONTH
- 21 (2) AN employee DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) shall -, if he
- 22 makes application to his employer for reinstatement within 15
- 23 days following his release or rejection, be reinstated in his OR
- 24 HER EMPLOYMENT position without reduction in his OR HER seniori-
- 25 ty, status, or pay IF HE OR SHE APPLIES FOR REINSTATEMENT WITH
- 26 HIS OR HER EMPLOYER WITHIN 15 DAYS AFTER BEING RELEASED FROM,
- 27 DENIED ADMISSION TO, OR FAILING TO MEET THE PHYSICAL FITNESS

- 3 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION
- 4 (A) "POLICE OFFICER" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION
- 5 42 OF THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, ACT NO 300 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS
- 6 OF 1949, BEING SECTION 257 42 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS
- 7 (B) "WEEKEND" MEANS THE 48-HOUR PERIOD BEGINNING AT 12 01
- 8 A M EACH SATURDAY AND ENDING AT 12 MIDNIGHT EACH SUNDAY
