

SENATE BILL No. 1309

November 29, 1994, Introduced by Senators DILLINGHAM, GEAKE and POLLACK and referred to the Committee on Health Policy and Senior Citizens.

A bill to amend Act No. 39 of the Public Acts of 1968, entitled as amended

"Michigan food law of 1968,"

as amended, being sections 289.701 to 289.727 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 7b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Act No. 39 of the Public Acts of 1968, as
- 2 amended, being sections 289.701 to 289.727 of the Michigan
- 3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 7b to read as
- 4 follows:
- 5 SEC. 7B. A RETAIL FOOD ESTABLISHMENT OR A RETAIL ESTABLISH-
- 6 MENT THAT SELLS OR OFFERS FOR SALE CHEWING GUM OR CANDY PRODUCTS
- 7 SHALL NOT SELL OR OFFER FOR SALE A CHEWING GUM OR CANDY PRODUCT
- 8 THAT IS DESIGNED OR PACKAGED TO IMITATE A CIGARETTE OR A PACKAGE
- 9 OF CIGARETTES.
