



SENATE BILL No. 1323

November 30, 1994, Introduced by Senator CARL and referred to the Committee on State Affairs and Military/Veteran Affairs.

A bill to amend Act No. 8 of the Public Acts of the Extra Session of 1933, entitled as amended "The Michigan liquor control act," as amended, being sections 436.1 to 436.58 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 28e.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 8 of the Public Acts of the Extra
2 Session of 1933, as amended, being sections 436.1 to 436.58 of
3 the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 28e to
4 read as follows:

5 SEC. 28E. (1) THE COMMISSION SHALL NOT REQUIRE AN
6 ON-PREMISES LICENSEE TO OBTAIN AN ENTERTAINMENT PERMIT OR OTHER
7 APPROVAL FROM THE COMMISSION FOR THE CONDUCT OF INTERACTIVE
8 ENTERTAINMENT ON THE LICENSE PREMISES.

1 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "INTERACTIVE ENTERTAINMENT"
2 MEANS AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION ENTERTAINMENT BY MEANS OF ELECTRONIC
3 BROADCASTS OF ANY TYPE INVOLVING THE USE OF COMPUTER KEYBOARDS OR
4 SIMILAR EQUIPMENT AND WHICH MAY PROVIDE FOR THE AWARD OF PRIZES.
