



SENATE BILL No. 1324

November 30, 1994, Introduced by Senator CARL and referred to the Committee on Family Law, Mental Health, and Corrections.

A bill to amend Act No. 280 of the Public Acts of 1939, entitled as amended
"The social welfare act,"
as amended, being sections 400.1 to 400.119b of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 16a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 280 of the Public Acts of 1939, as
2 amended, being sections 400.1 to 400.119b of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 16a to read as
4 follows:

5 SEC. 16A. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT SPEND PUBLIC FUNDS TO
6 ENABLE A PARENT WHO RESIDES OUTSIDE OF MICHIGAN TO VISIT HIS OR
7 HER CHILD IN MICHIGAN IF A PETITION IS PENDING IN PROBATE COURT
8 FOR THE TERMINATION OF THAT PARENT'S PARENTAL RIGHTS TO THE
9 CHILD.
