A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4380 AS INTRODUCED 2-9-95

Currently, the [child] Support and Visitation Enforcement Act (Public Act 295 of 1982) allows courts to order that child support payments be withheld from "income due the payer" by the "source" of income. The bill would amend the act to allow employers (who are one "source of income") to withhold up to five dollars from employees' paychecks as reimbursement for the employer's expense of executing any withholding orders.
