REPEAL INDIAN TUITION WAIVER

A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4777 AS INTRODUCED 5-5-95

The bill would repeal Public Act 174 of 1976, which provides for a college tuition waiver for North American Indians, defined in the law as persons who are able to show that they are not less than 1/4 quantum blood North American Indian as certified by the individual's tribal association and verified by the Michigan Commission on Indian Affairs. Public Act 174 requires public community colleges, public universities, and federal tribally controlled community colleges to waive tuition for any North American Indian who has been a legal resident of the state for more than 12 months and has qualified for admission as a full-time, part-time, or summer school student.
