A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5129 AS INTRODUCED 9-26-95

Public Act 156 of 1851, which defines the powers and duties of county boards of commissioners, allows for special meetings of county boards upon the request of at least one-third of the members and specifies how commissioners are to be notified of the requested meeting. House Bill 5129 would amend the act to require that notice be given to commissioners "in the manner required by the bylaws of the county board of commissioners." (The act currently requires notice to be delivered personally, to be left at the commissioner's residence, or sent by certified mail with return receipt requested, at least ten days before the time of the meeting. Those requirements would be deleted.)
