A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5711 AS INTRODUCED 3-26-96

The bill would amend the Revised School Code to specify that the provision dealing with "limited open forums" applies to a public school operating one or more of grades 7-12. The term refers to non-curriculum-related student groups meeting on school premises during non-instructional time. The code says a public school that has a limited open forum cannot deny equal access or a fair opportunity to, or discriminate against, any students who wish to conduct a meeting within that limited open forum on the basis of the religious, political, philosophical, or other content of the speech at the meeting.
