A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5742 AS INTRODUCED 4-16-96

The bill would amend the Revised School Code to specify that a child care center operated by a school district or intermediate school district would be subject to the requirements of the child care licensing act. However, a child care center would not be subject to any fire prevention or fire safety requirements of the child care licensing act if it was located in a school building approved and inspected for school purposes by the state fire marshal (or other similar authority) as provided in Public Act 306 of 1937, which deals with the construction and remodeling of school buildings, and was in compliance with school fire safety rules as determined by the state fire marshal or a fire inspector under the Fire Prevention Code.
