# THE APPARENT PROBLEM:

When laws relating to the environment and natural resources were recodified under Public Act 451 of 1994 to create the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act (NREPA), many statutes were repealed and their provisions incorporated into the NREPA. However, various acts still contain references to these repealed statutes.

### THE CONTENT OF THE BILL:

The bill would amend the Shared Credit Rating Act to replace references to the State Clean Water Assistance Act, which was repealed and incorporated into the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act (NREPA), with references to the new provisions within the NREPA.

#### For:

The bill would simply make a technical amendment to the Shared Credit Rating Act, replacing a reference to an act that has been repealed with a correct reference to the corresponding provisions of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act.
