SUMMARY OF SENATE BILL 471 as introduced 4-26-95:

The bill would amend the Ski Area Safety Act to include in the definition of "skier" a person using "a device that attaches to at least 1 foot or the lower torso for the purpose of sliding on a slope" and that "slides on the snow or other surface of a slope and is capable of being maneuvered and controlled by the person using the device". "Skier" also would include a person not wearing a skiing device while the person was in a ski area for the purpose of skiing. Currently, the term refers to a person wearing skis and includes a person not wearing skis while in a ski area for the purpose of skiing. "Ski area" means an area used for skiing and served by one or more ski lifts.
