CONTENT

The bill would amend the Insurance Code to delete the January 1, 1997, sunset on a requirement that the Insurance Commissioner waive the Code's continuing education requirements for an agent who is licensed to write only travel or baggage insurance policies and whose employment is for a purpose other than the sale of those policies.

In addition, the Code requires that the Insurance Commissioner approve a program of study for continuing education if he or she determines that the program increases knowledge of insurance and related subjects by offering instruction in any of a list of subject areas. The bill would add "principles of agency management" to that list of subjects.
