CONTENT

The bill would amend the Revised Judicature Act to increase the maximum rate a publication may charge for publishing a legal notice, order, citation, summons, or other matter required by law to be published in a newspaper. The maximum rates would be increased from \$13.75 to \$20 per folio for the first insertion, and from \$5.35 to \$8 per folio for subsequent insertions. The minimum rate for notices that must appear two or more times would increase from \$39 to \$55, and the minimum rate for notices that appear once would increase from \$29 to \$40. The bill would take effect June 1, 1996.

(According to the <u>Black's Law Dictionary</u> definition of "folio", "When used in connection with legal documents, it means a certain number of words varying from 72 to 100, but generally in the United States consisting of 100.")
