CONTENT

The bills would amend various acts regulating cemeteries to prohibit corporations and registrants regulated by the acts from charging a fee to witness a burial. <u>House Bill 5258</u> would amend Public Act 12 of 1869, which regulates corporations formed to establish rural cemeteries. <u>House Bill 5259</u> would amend Public Act 87 of 1855, which governs burial grounds. <u>House Bill 5260</u> would amend the Cemetery Regulation Act.
