CONTENT

The bills would amend various acts regulating cemeteries to prohibit corporations and registrants regulated by the acts from charging a fee to witness a burial. House Bill 5258 would amend Public Act 12 of 1869, which regulates corporations formed to establish rural cemeteries. House Bill 5259 would amend Public Act 87 of 1855, which governs burial grounds. House Bill 5260 would amend the Cemetery Regulation Act.
