### **CONTENT**

The bill would amend Public Act 58 of 1945, which authorizes county boards of commissioners to establish and maintain parking lots, to delete the \$10 limit on fines for violating county parking lot violations.

### **FISCAL IMPACT**

This bill would eliminate the \$10 limit on civil fines for violating parking regulations. Counties that implement civil fines above \$10 would increase the revenue collections from parking violations.
