ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 5258

AN ACT to amend Act No. 12 of the Public Acts of 1869, entitled as amended "An act to authorize and encourage the formation of corporations to establish rural cemeteries; to provide for the care and maintenance thereof; to provide for the revision and codification of the laws relating to cemeteries, mausoleums, crypts, vaults, crematoriums, and other means of disposing of the dead; to make an appropriation therefor; and to impose certain duties upon the department of commerce," as amended, being sections 456.101 to 456.119 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 14a.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Act No. 12 of the Public Acts of 1869, as amended, being sections 456.101 to 456.119 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 14a to read as follows:

Sec. 14a. A corporation established under the provisions of this act shall not charge a fee for witnessing the lowering of a casket into the ground.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
