ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 5259

AN ACT to amend Act No. 87 of the Public Acts of 1855, entitled as amended "An act relative to burying grounds; and to impose certain duties upon the department of commerce," as amended, being sections 456.1 to 456.36 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 34a.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Act No. 87 of the Public Acts of 1855, as amended, being sections 456.1 to 456.36 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 34a to read as follows:

Sec. 34a. A corporation organized under this act shall not charge a fee for witnessing the lowering of a casket into the ground.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
