ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 5260

AN ACT to amend Act No. 251 of the Public Acts of 1968, entitled as amended "An act to regulate the creation and management of cemeteries; to regulate the sale of cemetery services and merchandise; to provide for a cemetery commissioner, and to prescribe the powers and duties of the commissioner; to require the registration and audit of cemeteries; to regulate persons selling burial, entombment, or columbarium rights, cemetery services, or cemetery merchandise; and to prescribe penalties," as amended, being sections 456.521 to 456.543 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 15a.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Act No. 251 of the Public Acts of 1968, as amended, being sections 456.521 to 456.543 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 15a to read as follows:

Sec. 15a. A registrant shall not charge a fee for witnessing the lowering of a casket into the ground.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
