ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 5285

AN ACT to amend section 8b of Act No. 116 of the Public Acts of 1923, entitled as amended "An act to authorize certain township or village public improvements and services; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts," as added by Act No. 82 of the Public Acts of 1989, being section 41.418b of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Section 8b of Act No. 116 of the Public Acts of 1923, as added by Act No. 82 of the Public Acts of 1989, being section 41.418b of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 8b. (1) A pesticide shall not be used for weed control in an inland lake except with the consent of, and under the supervision of, the department of natural resources.

(2) As used in this section, "pesticide" means that term as defined in section 8305 of part 83 (pesticide control) of the natural resources and environmental protection act, Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1994, being section 324.8305 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
