AN ACT to amend section 10 of Act No. 187 of the Public Acts of 1990, entitled "An act to regulate the equipment, maintenance, operation, and use of school buses and pupil transportation vehicles; to prescribe the qualifications of school bus and pupil transportation vehicle drivers; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local governmental agencies; to create an advisory committee and to prescribe its powers and duties; and to prescribe remedies and penalties," being section 257.1810 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## The People of the State of Michigan enact:

- Section 1. Section 10 of Act No. 187 of the Public Acts of 1990, being section 257.1810 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 10. (1) Each motor vehicle owned by a public, private, or governmental agency and operated for the transportation of passengers to or from school and school related events shall meet or exceed the passenger protection federal motor vehicle safety standards applicable to the construction and sale of that vehicle. A vehicle for which there are no applicable passenger protection federal motor vehicle safety standards shall not be used to transport passengers to and from school and school related events.
  - (2) Vehicles, other than school buses, shall meet the requirements of this section by October 1, 2002.
- (3) A school shall not purchase a vehicle to be used to transport passengers to and from school and school related events that does not meet or exceed the passenger protection federal motor vehicle safety standards applicable to that vehicle. A school shall not purchase a vehicle to be used to transport passengers to and from school and school related events for which there are no applicable passenger protection federal motor vehicle safety standards. This subsection shall apply to vehicles, other than school buses, purchased on or after October 1, 1993.
- (4) Vehicles used by parents or a parent's designee to transport their children to and from school and school related events under contract with the school are exempt from the requirements of this section.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
