ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 5557

AN ACT to designate a portion of interstate highway 275 as the "Disabled American Veterans Memorial Highway"; and to prescribe the duties of the state transportation department.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

- Sec. 1. Interstate highway 275 north of the Livonia intersection of interstate highway 275 and interstate highway 96 shall be known as the "Disabled American Veterans Memorial Highway".
- Sec. 2. The state transportation department shall provide for the erection of suitable markers upon the highway indicating the name of the highway.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
