## ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 6204

AN ACT to amend section 217 of Act No. 234 of the Public Acts of 1992, entitled "An act to establish a judges retirement system; to provide for the administration and maintenance of the retirement system; to create a retirement board; to prescribe the powers and duties of the retirement board; to establish certain reserves for the retirement system; to establish certain funds; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state departments and certain state and local officials and employees; to prescribe penalties and provide remedies; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts," being section 38.2217 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Section 217 of Act No. 234 of the Public Acts of 1992, being section 38.2217 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 217. (1) A court fee fund is created in the state treasury. The state treasurer shall deposit into the court fee fund all money received from the executive secretary pursuant to section 304(4). The state treasurer shall transmit the money in the court fee fund, not exceeding \$2,200,000.00 in any fiscal year, to the court equity fund created by section 151b of the revised judicature act, being section 600.151b of the Michigan Compiled Laws, for operational expenses of trial courts. Any money remaining in the court fee fund at the end of the fiscal year shall remain in the court fee fund and shall not revert to the general fund.

(2) This section applies unless the department receives notification from the United States internal revenue service that this section will cause the retirement system to be disqualified for tax purposes under the internal revenue code.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
