ENROLLED SENATE BILL No. 391

AN ACT to repeal section 78 of Act No. 380 of the Public Acts of 1965, entitled "An act to organize the executive and administrative agencies of state government; to establish principal departments and department heads; to define the powers and duties of the principal departments and their governing agents; to allocate executive and administrative powers, duties, functions, and services among the principal departments; to provide for a method for the gradual implementation of the provisions of this act and for the transfer of existing funds and appropriations of the principal departments herein created and established," being section 16.178 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Section 78 of Act No. 380 of the Public Acts of 1965, being section 16.178 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is repealed effective January 1, 1996.

Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless Senate Bill No. 390 of the 88th Legislature is enacted into law.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
