## ENROLLED SENATE BILL No. 579

AN ACT to amend section 3 of Act No. 203 of the Public Acts of 1965, entitled "An act to provide for the creation of a law enforcement officers training council; to provide for additional costs in criminal cases and the establishment of the law enforcement officers training fund and allocations therefrom to local agencies of government participating in a police training program," being section 28.603 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

- Section 1. Section 3 of Act No. 203 of the Public Acts of 1965, being section 28.603 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 3. (1) The law enforcement council is created to carry out the intent of this act and to consist of 11 members selected as follows:
  - (a) The attorney general, or his or her designated representative.
  - (b) The commissioner of state police, or his or her designated representative.
- (c) Three members appointed to the council by the governor from a list of 6 active members submitted by the Michigan association of chiefs of police.
- (d) Three members appointed to the council by the governor from a list of 6 active law enforcement officials submitted by the Michigan sheriffs association.
- (e) One member appointed to the council by the governor from a list of 3 names submitted by the fraternal order of the police.
- (f) One member appointed to the council by the governor from a list of 3 names submitted by the police officers association of Michigan.
- (g) One member appointed to the council by the governor from a list of 3 names submitted by the Detroit police officers associations.

(2) All appointments made by the governor under this act a	are subject to the advice and consent of the senate.
This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
