ENROLLED SENATE BILL No. 840

AN ACT to amend Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, entitled as amended "An act to protect and promote the public health; to codify, revise, consolidate, classify, and add to the laws relating to public health; to provide for the prevention and control of diseases and disabilities; to provide for the classification, administration, regulation, financing, and maintenance of personal, environmental, and other health services and activities; to create or continue, and prescribe the powers and duties of, departments, boards, commissions, councils, committees, task forces, and other agencies; to prescribe the powers and duties of governmental entities and officials; to regulate occupations, facilities, and agencies affecting the public health; to regulate health maintenance organizations and certain third party administrators and insurers; to provide for the imposition of a regulatory fee; to promote the efficient and economical delivery of health care services, to provide for the appropriate utilization of health care facilities and services, and to provide for the closure of hospitals or consolidation of hospitals or services; to provide for the collection and use of data and information; to provide for the transfer of property; to provide certain immunity from liability; to regulate and prohibit the sale and offering for sale of drug paraphernalia under certain circumstances; to provide for penalties and remedies; to provide for sanctions for violations of this act and local ordinances; to repeal certain acts and parts of acts; to repeal certain parts of this act; and to repeal certain parts of this act on specific dates," as amended, being sections 333.1101 to 333.25211 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 13407.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, as amended, being sections 333.1101 to 333.25211 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 13407 to read as follows:

Sec. 13407. (1) Before allowing a minor who is under 18 years of age to use a tanning device in a tanning facility, the owner or operator of the tanning facility shall require the presentment of a statement similar to the statement required under section 13405 signed by the minor's parent or legal guardian indicating that the parent or legal guardian has read and understood the statement required under section 13403(1), consents to the minor's use of a tanning device, and agrees that the minor will use protective eyewear.

- (2) The owner or operator of a tanning facility shall not allow a minor who is less than 14 years of age to use a tanning device in the tanning facility unless the minor is accompanied to the tanning facility by a parent or legal guardian and the parent or legal guardian signs a statement in the same manner as required under subsection (1).
 - (3) An individual who uses a tanning device in a tanning facility shall use protective eyewear.
- (4) For purposes of this section, "minor" does not include a minor who is emancipated pursuant to section 4 of Act No. 293 of the Public Acts of 1968, being section 722.4 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

Section 2. This amendatory act shall take effect September 1, 1996.
