ENROLLED SENATE BILL No. 1209

AN ACT to amend the title and sections 1, 2, and 3 of Act No. 152 of the Public Acts of 1929, entitled as amended "An act to provide for a state-owned and operated radio broadcasting station for police purposes only, and to provide for radio receiving sets to be used in connection therewith; to provide for the purchase of materials and the construction of the necessary apparatus, or the purchase of the required equipment; and to define the powers and duties of the commissioner of the Michigan state police hereunder," being sections 28.281, 28.282, and 28.283 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. The title and sections 1, 2, and 3 of Act No. 152 of the Public Acts of 1929, being sections 28.281, 28.282, and 28.283 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:

TITLE

An act to provide for the state-owned and operated Michigan public safety communications system for police and public safety purposes; to provide for acquisition, construction, implementation, operation, and maintenance of the property and equipment necessary to operate the system; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies and officials.

- Sec. 1. The Michigan public safety communications system is an 800-megahertz radio system and telecommunication network within the department of state police and includes all real and personal property, towers, buildings, equipment, and other related facilities and fixtures necessary for the operation and maintenance of the system.
- Sec. 2. (1) The director of the department of state police and the director of the department of management and budget are responsible for the construction, implementation, operation, and maintenance of the Michigan public safety communications system.
- (2) In siting the buildings and equipment necessary to implement the Michigan public safety communications system, the director of the department of state police shall locate the system, a local unit of government with zoning authority shall be notified of a site selected in their jurisdiction and the requirements necessary for a site. If the selected site does not comply with zoning, the local unit shall have 30 days from the date of notification to grant a special use permit or propose an equivalent site. If the local unit does not grant a special use permit within the 30 day period, or a proposed alternate site does not meet the siting requirements, the department may proceed with construction.

- Sec. 3. (1) The department of state police shall broadcast all police dispatches and reports which have a reasonable relation to or connection with the apprehension of criminals, the prevention of crime, or the maintenance of peace, order, and public safety in this state.
- (2) The director of the department of state police may authorize any governmental public safety agency to utilize the Michigan public safety communications system.

Section 2. Section 7 of Act No. 152 of the Public Acts of 1929, being section 28.287 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is repealed.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
