

HOUSE BILL No. 4057

January 11, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Dalman, Horton, Hammerstrom, McManus, Sikkema, DeLange, Bush, Lowe, Green, Geiger and Voorhees and referred to the Committee on Senior Citizens and Veterans' Affairs.

A bill to amend section 411 of Act No. 150 of the Public Acts of 1967, entitled

"Michigan military act,"

as amended by Act No. 280 of the Public Acts of 1980, being section 32.811 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 411 of Act No. 150 of the Public Acts of 2 1967, as amended by Act No. 280 of the Public Acts of 1980, being 3 section 32.811 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read 4 as follows:
- Sec. 411. (1) A person who has completed not less than 20 6 years of active service with the national guard or defense force, 7 or both, may retire and receive retirement pay under 1 or more of 8 the following circumstances:

- 1 (a) Attainment of 62 years of age.
- 2 (b) Ineligibility, because of federal law or regulation, for
- 3 further federal recognition in the person's current grade -by
- 4 reason BECAUSE of age or length of service, and termination of
- 5 the person's commission or enlistment in the national guard of
- 6 the United States.
- 7 (c) Withdrawal of the person's federal recognition and ter-
- 8 mination of the person's commission or enlistment in the national
- 9 guard of the United States because of physical disqualification
- 10 from further service.
- (d) Separation from the national guard or defense force
- 12 under an honorable circumstance AT ANY TIME BEFORE OR AFTER JUNE
- 13 30, 1967.
- (2) A person who retires under subsection (1)(a) shall
- 15 receive pay of \$600.00 per year. upon reaching 62 years of age.
- 16 A person who retires under subsection (1)(b), (c), or (d) shall
- 17 receive pay of \$600.00 per year upon reaching 55 years of age.
- 18 (3) Upon the death of a person eligible to receive retire-
- 19 ment pay under subsection (1), the A surviving spouse shall
- 20 receive \$300.00 per year until death.
