



HOUSE BILL No. 4189

January 30, 1995, Introduced by Rep. Schroer and referred to the Committee on Agriculture and Forestry.

A bill to amend Act No. 171 of the Public Acts of 1976,
entitled as amended
"Pesticide control act,"
as amended, being sections 286.551 to 286.581 of the Michigan
Compiled Laws, by adding section 13e.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 171 of the Public Acts of 1976, as
2 amended, being sections 286.551 to 286.581 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 13e to read as
4 follows:

5 SEC. 13E. (1) BY APRIL 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
6 ISSUE A HEALTH-RISK ASSESSMENT AND COST-BENEFIT ANALYSIS ADVISORY
7 REGARDING THE HEALTH RISKS AND THE BENEFITS AND RISKS ASSOCIATED
8 WITH THE APPLICATION OF PESTICIDES TO CONTROL PESTS WITHIN URBAN
9 AND RESIDENTIAL AREAS. IN ADDITION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE

1 INFORMATION REGARDING INTEGRATED PEST MANAGEMENT TO ALERT

2 CONSUMERS TO ALTERNATIVE PEST MANAGEMENT STRATEGIES.

3 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SUPPLY THE ADVISORY REQUIRED UNDER

4 SUBSECTION (1) TO ANY PERSON UPON REQUEST.
