

## HOUSE BILL No. 4211

January 30, 1995, Introduced by Rep. Llewellyn and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Environment and Great Lakes.

A bill to amend section 13 of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of 1989, entitled

"Dam safety act,"

being section 281.1313 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 13 of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1989, being section 281.1313 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 13. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsections
- 5 (2) and (3), dams and impoundments in the state are under the
- 6 jurisdiction of the department.
- 7 (2) The following are exempt from this act:
- 8 (a) Projects licensed, projects that have preliminary
- 9 permits, or projects for which an application for licensure has
- 10 been filed under the federal power act, chapter 285, 41

- 1 Stat. 1063, 16 U.S.C. 791a to 793, 796 to 797, 798 to 818, 820 to
- 2 824a, and 824b to 825r, if federal dam safety inspection provi-
- 3 sions apply during the license period and the inspection reports
- 4 are provided to the department.
- 5 (b) Projects located on boundary waters under the jurisdic-
- 6 tion and supervision of the United States army corps of
- 7 engineers.
- 8 (c) Impoundments licensed pursuant to the solid waste man-
- 9 agement act, Act No. 641 of the Public Acts of 1978, being sec-
- 10 tions 299.401 to 299.437 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, that con-
- 11 tain or are designed to contain type III wastes as defined in
- 12 rules promulgated under that act.
- 13 (3) For 3 years commencing December 28, 1988, UNTIL
- 14 JANUARY 1, 1998, a permit shall not be required under this act
- 15 for the repair, reconstruction, or improvement of a dam -located
- 16 in Everett township, Newaygo county, and/or a dam located in the
- 17 village of Luther, Lake county, which THAT is AT LEAST 75 years
- 18 old, -if the dam was damaged or destroyed by an act of God, AND
- 19 IS LOCATED IN A COUNTY THAT HAS A PER CAPITA INCOME OF LESS THAN
- 20 8,500. in 1986. However, a person who is performing a project
- 21 for the repair, reconstruction, or improvement of a dam that is
- 22 exempt from obtaining a permit under this subsection shall submit
- 23 to the department and the joint capital outlay committee plans
- 24 and specifications for the project. These plans and specifica-
- 25 tions shall be prepared by a licensed professional engineer and
- 26 shall meet acceptable standards in the industry and must be
- 27 approved by the joint capital outlay committee in order for a dam

- 1 to be repaired, reconstructed, or improved. In reviewing for
- 2 approval plans and specifications for the project, the joint cap
- 3 ital outlay committee may require environmental considerations to
- 4 protect water quality such as underspill devices, minimum flow
- 5 releases and removal of contaminated sediments that may be resus-
- 6 pended in the water column upon impoundment. Such contaminated
- 7 sediments shall be disposed of in accordance with state law.
