

HOUSE BILL No. 4278

February 1, 1995, Introduced by Reps. LeTarte, DeHart, Kukuk, Hill, McBryde, Voorhees, Bodem, Hammerstrom, Green, Weeks, Middleton, Martinez, Dalman, Tesanovich, Brewer, Gernaat, Hanley, Baade, Oxender and Pitoniak and referred to the Committee on Senior Citizens and Veterans Affairs.

A bill to amend Act No. 331 of the Public Acts of 1976, entitled

"Michigan consumer protection act,"

as amended, being sections 445.901 to 445.922 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 11a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Act No. 331 of the Public Acts of 1976, as
- 2 amended, being sections 445.901 to 445.922 of the Michigan
- 3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 11a to read as
- 4 follows:
- 5 SEC. 11A. (1) IN ADDITION TO IMPOSING ANY OTHER PENALTY OR
- 6 PROVIDING ANY OTHER REMEDY UNDER THIS ACT, A COURT MAY IMPOSE A
- 7 CIVIL FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$10,000.00 AGAINST A PERSON FOR EACH
- 8 ACT OR OMISSION OF THAT PERSON THAT VIOLATES THIS ACT AND
- 9 ADVERSELY AFFECTS AN OLDER OR DISABLED PERSON. A FINE COLLECTED

- 1 UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN THE STATE TREASURY AND
- 2 CREDITED TO THE OLDER AND DISABLED VICTIMS FUND CREATED IN SUB-
- 3 SECTION (4).
- 4 (2) IN DETERMINING WHETHER TO IMPOSE A CIVIL FINE UNDER THIS
- 5 SECTION, THE COURT SHALL CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING:
- 6 (A) WHETHER THE DEFENDANT'S CONDUCT WAS IN DISREGARD OF THE
- 7 RIGHTS OF AN OLDER OR DISABLED PERSON.
- 8 (B) WHETHER THE DEFENDANT KNEW OR SHOULD HAVE KNOWN THAT THE
- 9 DEFENDANT'S CONDUCT WAS DIRECTED TO AN OLDER OR DISABLED PERSON.
- 10 (C) WHETHER THE OLDER OR DISABLED PERSON WAS MORE VULNERABLE
- 11 TO THE DEFENDANT'S CONDUCT BECAUSE OF AGE, POOR HEALTH, INFIRMI-
- 2 TY, IMPAIRED UNDERSTANDING, RESTRICTED MOBILITY, OR DISABILITY
- 13 THAN OTHER PERSONS AND WHETHER THE OLDER OR DISABLED PERSON ACTU-
- 14 ALLY SUFFERED SUBSTANTIAL PHYSICAL, EMOTIONAL, OR ECONOMIC DAMAGE
- 15 RESULTING FROM THE DEFENDANT'S CONDUCT.
- 16 (D) WHETHER THE DEFENDANT'S CONDUCT CAUSED AN OLDER OR DIS-
- 17 ABLED PERSON TO SUFFER ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 18 (i) MENTAL OR EMOTIONAL ANGUISH.
- 19 (ii) LOSS OF OR ENCUMBRANCE UPON A PRIMARY RESIDENCE OF THE
- 20 OLDER OR DISABLED PERSON.
- 21 (iii) LOSS OF OR ENCUMBRANCE UPON THE OLDER OR DISABLED
- 22 PERSON'S PRINCIPAL EMPLOYMENT OR PRINCIPAL SOURCE OF INCOME.
- (iv) LOSS OF FUNDS RECEIVED UNDER A PENSION OR RETIREMENT
- 24 PLAN OR A GOVERNMENT BENEFITS PROGRAM.
- 25 (v) LOSS OF PROPERTY SET ASIDE FOR RETIREMENT OR FOR PER-
- 26 SONAL OR FAMILY CARE AND MAINTENANCE.

- 1 (vi) LOSS OF ASSETS ESSENTIAL TO THE HEALTH AND WELFARE OF 2 THE OLDER OR DISABLED PERSON.
- 3 (E) ANY OTHER FACTORS THE COURT DEEMS APPROPRIATE.
- 4 (3) THE OFFICE OF SERVICES TO THE AGING SHALL DEVELOP AND
- 5 IMPLEMENT A STATEWIDE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM TO INFORM OLDER PERSONS
- 6 AND DISABLED PERSONS, LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES, THE JUDICIAL
- 7 SYSTEM, SOCIAL SERVICES PROFESSIONALS, AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC OF
- 8 BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 9 (A) THE PREVALENCE AND PREVENTION OF CONSUMER CRIMES AGAINST
- 10 OLDER AND DISABLED PERSONS.
- (B) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT, INCLUDING THE PENALTIES FOR
- 12 VIOLATIONS OF THIS ACT AND THE REMEDIES AVAILABLE FOR VICTIMS OF
- 13 THOSE VIOLATIONS.
- 14 (4) THE OLDER AND DISABLED VICTIMS FUND IS CREATED WITHIN
- 15 THE STATE TREASURY.
- (5) THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS
- 17 FROM ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER
- 18 SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER
- 19 SHALL CREDIT TO THE FUND INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM FUND
- 20 INVESTMENTS. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL ANNUALLY PRESENT TO THE
- 21 OFFICE OF SERVICES TO THE AGING AN ACCOUNTING OF THE AMOUNT OF
- 22 MONEY IN THE FUND.
- 23 (6) MONEY IN THE FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL
- 24 REMAIN IN THE FUND AND SHALL NOT LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND.
- 25 (7) THE OFFICE OF SERVICES TO THE AGING SHALL EXPEND MONEY
- 26 FROM THE FUND TO IMPLEMENT A CONSUMER EDUCATION PROGRAM AS

- 1 REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (3) AND TO PROVIDE OTHER SERVICES AS
- 2 REQUIRED BY LAW.
- 3 (8) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 4 (A) "DISABLED PERSON" MEANS A PERSON WHO HAS A DISABILITY AS
- 5 THAT TERM IS DEFINED IN SECTION 216 OF TITLE II OF THE SOCIAL
- 6 SECURITY ACT, CHAPTER 531, 49 STAT. 620, 42 U.S.C. 416.
- 7 (B) "FUND" MEANS THE OLDER AND DISABLED VICTIMS FUND CREATED
- 8 PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (4).
- 9 (C) "OFFICE OF SERVICES TO THE AGING" MEANS THE ENTITY CRE-
- 10 ATED BY SECTION 5 OF THE OLDER MICHIGANIANS ACT, ACT NO. 180 OF
- 11 THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1981, BEING SECTION 400.585 OF THE MICHIGAN
- 12 COMPILED LAWS.
- 13 (D) "OLDER PERSON" MEANS A PERSON WHO IS 60 YEARS OF AGE OR 14 OLDER.
