



HOUSE BILL No. 4406

February 15, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Murphy, Freeman and Curtis and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Civil Rights.

A bill to amend section 8602 of Act No. 236 of the Public Acts of 1961, entitled as amended "Revised judicature act of 1961," as amended by Act No. 308 of the Public Acts of 1986, being section 600.8602 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 8602 of Act No. 236 of the Public Acts
2 of 1961, as amended by Act No. 308 of the Public Acts of 1986,
3 being section 600.8602 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended
4 to read as follows:

5 Sec. 8602. (1) Each judge of the district court shall
6 appoint his or her own recorder or reporter, EXCEPT THAT IN THE
7 THIRTY-SIXTH DISTRICT THE CHIEF JUDGE SHALL APPOINT THE RECORDER
8 OR REPORTER FOR EACH JUDGE OF THAT DISTRICT.

1 (2) Pursuant to supreme court rule, the chief or only judge
2 of the district may appoint additional certified recorders or
3 reporters. Appointed additional recorders or reporters shall
4 perform the duties and functions of recorder or reporter when so
5 assigned and shall perform other functions and duties as may be
6 assigned by the chief or only judge of the district or the court
7 administrator.
