

## **HOUSE BILL No. 4431**

A bill to amend section 107 of Act No. 280 of the Public Acts of 1939, entitled as amended
"The social welfare act,"

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 107 of Act No. 280 of the Public Acts of

- 15 PERSON OTHER THAN THE FOLLOWING:
