



# HOUSE BILL No. 4470

February 28, 1995, Introduced by Rep. Willard and referred to the Committee on Senior Citizens and Veterans Affairs.

A bill to amend Act No. 9 of the Public Acts of the First Extra Session of 1946, entitled as amended

"An act to create the Michigan veterans' trust fund, and to define who shall be eligible to receive assistance therefrom; to provide for the disbursement of the income thereof and surplus therein; to create a board of trustees, and to prescribe its powers and duties; to provide for county and district committees, and their powers, duties, and expenses; to prescribe penalties; and to make appropriations to carry out the provisions of this act,"

as amended, being sections 35.601 to 35.610 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 4b; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 9 of the Public Acts of the First Extra  
2 Session of 1946, as amended, being sections 35.601 to 35.610 of  
3 the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 4b to  
4 read as follows:

1           SEC. 4B. THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL ADMINISTER THE  
2 MICHIGAN VETERANS' TRUST FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER SECTION 37 OF  
3 ARTICLE IX OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION OF 1963.

4           Section 2. Section 1 of Act No. 9 of the Public Acts of the  
5 First Extra Session of 1946, being section 35.601 of the Michigan  
6 Compiled Laws, is repealed effective 1 year after the effective  
7 date of this amendatory act.

8           Section 3. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless  
9 House Joint Resolution H of the 88th Legislature becomes a part  
10 of the state constitution of 1963 as provided in section 1 of  
11 article XII of the state constitution of 1963.
